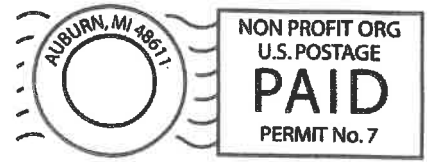

## **Forgiven and Forgiving - a Message from Pastor Hemme**

We struggle with forgiving others. We lose patience with those who we disagree with. We are quick to point out the faults of others. We like to think we are better than others. What does God have to say about these attitudes? God calls us to forgive others and live at peace with one another. We can forgive others because we have been forgiven by God. All of our sins have been forgiven by Jesus. Jesus' death on Good Friday and resurrection on Easter Sunday won for us forgiveness, life, and salvation. Martin Luther wrote these words reflecting on John 1:29: *The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"*

"From this passage, we learn that all people have been plunged into sin by the devil and that only the Lamb can lead us out. Our unbelief isn't Jesus' fault. The guilt is ours. If we don't believe, then we're stuck in our own sins. In short, the Lamb of God has carried the sins of the world.

You should believe and confess this all of your life. You may wonder, "Yes, I know that Jesus carried the sins of Peter, Paul, and other saints. They were holy people. But who knows if Christ will carry my sins, too? If only I were as good as Peter or Paul." Can't you hear what John is saying? "This is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." You must admit that you, too, are a part of this world. You were born of a human mother and father, you aren't a cow or pig! It follows, then, that your sins are paid for, just as the sins of Peter and Paul are paid for. You are unable to pay for your own sins. They couldn't pay for their own sins either. There are no exceptions.

Therefore, don't listen to your own thoughts. Listen to God's Word. It promises forgiveness of sins to anyone who believes that this little Lamb carried the sins of the whole world. Did you hear that? The Lamb didn't miss any of it. He carried all the sins of the world from the beginning of time. Therefore, he carried your sin, too, and he offers his undeserved kindness to you."

You are forgiven. Jesus loves you. And you are called to forgive others. Show mercy and grace to those who have wronged you. Be loving to those who you find hard to love. Strive to live at peace with your family, friends, co-workers, and neighbors. May you live as God's forgiven and forgiving child.

## Preschool and Day School News

We currently have 83 students enrolled for the 2021/2022 school year which is an increase from the 74 students we had from last year. Preschool is full with 20 enrolled students, half of them being full day students.

The staff and myself are starting to prep, plan, and prepare as we get ready to endure the Accreditation process. This process is rather detailed and precise in showing evidence of the high quality education we provide in a well kept and maintained environment. We will be asking some congregation members to help us during this process too. It is a collaborative effort to continue to hold the title of an "Nationally Accredited" school. There will be a meeting in the near future to work on this.

Our staff went through many different types of training in the last couple of months; First Aid and CPR, Concussion training, Bloodborne Pathogens, Crisis Management, and Stop the Bleed. All of these different training sessions help our staff to be prepared in the case of emergencies or injuries.

We are looking forward to having events at school again; Apple Pies, Smorgasbord, Special Person's Day and more. We would love help on Oct. 13-16 for Apple Pies. Please contact the office for dates and times to volunteer.

We held our Special Person's Day on September 17. It appeared that most students had a special person or two to bring and we started the event off with chapel. Afterwards the students took their special people around the school completing a checklist to explain and share their favorite things about our school.

Our soccer season was an interesting one as we battled severe weather, heavy rains, and game cancellations. However the games we were able to play were successful. Our A-team went undefeated in the league and in the tournament, bringing home two championship trophies. Our pee wee teams also did great. The 4th and 5th grade team had a successful season with only one loss as they dominated the field. Our second and third graders did a great job learning the basics, ball handling, and working together. We will start our next sports season of volleyball during the month of October and November.



I will be attending the Michigan Association of Nonpublic Schools Administrators Conference October 13th through the 15th. It's always a great conference held every other year to help strengthen and preserve Christian education.
